Subject: Re-allocation of Targets for Educational loan-reg.

Sir/ Madam,

This has reference to this Department's letter of even number dated 26th July, 2012 regarding allocation of State-wise targets on education loans based on the data collected from Public Sector Banks.

2. It has been observed that there is discrepancy in the data reported by the Convenors of State Level Bankers Committee (SLBC) and data collected from Public Sector Banks. It has, therefore, been decided to re-allocate the State-wise target on education loans to the convenors of SLBC on the following basis:

- a) The States whose achievement is less than the national average have been allocated growth of 20% in number of accounts and 30% in amount outstanding;
- b) The States whose achievement is more than the national average have been allocated growth of 15% in number of accounts and 20% in amount outstanding.

3. **A copy of the re-allocated target is enclosed at Annexure-I, for your ready reference. The SLBC Convenors are, accordingly, requested to allocate targets to all banks in their State.**

4. This letter may kindly be acknowledged and action taken report be furnished by return of fax/ mail at cmsec-bkg@nic.in and pande.alok@nic.in. The action taken report must include the targets allocated to banks in the States/ UTs along with the monitoring mechanism to achieve the targets.
