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### ORDER:

The 40<sup>th</sup> State Level Coordination Committee on Crop Insurance meeting for notifying Kharif Crops during 2018-2019 under Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana (PMFBY) was held on 27.3.2018 and the Committee accepted to notify the Crops, Districts, Firkas and Revenue Villages for Agricultural and Horticultural Crops and for notification of Insurance Units and publication in the State Gazette.

2. In his letter second read above, the Director of Agriculture has stated that the Sowing Season for Kharif Crops in Tamil Nadu commences in the month of April and prolongs upto September. Hence the Crops / Insurance units need to be notified for implementation of PMFBY during Kharif 2018. Accordingly, the 40<sup>th</sup> State level Coordination Committee meeting was conducted on 27.03.2018 to notify Kharif Agricultural & Horticultural Crops during 2018-2019 under PMFBY and the Committee has notified the insurance units and approved premium rates. In accordance to this he has sent a proposal for notification of Kharif Crops during 2018-2019 and requested the Government to issue orders and also publish the notification in the Government Gazette.

3. The Government, after careful examination of the proposal of the Director of Agriculture accept the same and accordingly hereby notify the Crops, Districts, Firkas, Revenue Villages, insurance units and approved premium rates for Agricultural Crops and Horticultural Crops for the effective implementation of the Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana during Kharif, 2018 season as shown in the Annexures I, II, III and IV to this order.

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4. The claims under the Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana Scheme shall be settled on the basis of yield data furnished by the Director, Department of Economics and Statistics as per prescribed cut-off dates for the notified crops / districts / firkas / revenue villages for the effective implementation of Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana scheme for Kharif, 2018 season and not on the basis of the Annavari Certificate / Gazette notification declaring the area as Drought / Flood / Cyclone affected etc., by the District Collectors.

**PRADHAN MANTRI FASAL BIMA YOJANA (PMFBY)**

**NOTIFICATION FOR KHARIF CROPS DURING 2018-2019**

**ANNEXURE I to G.O.(Ms).No.123, Agriculture (AP.2) Department, dated 3.5.2018.**

Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana (PMFBY) will be implemented in all the districts of Tamil Nadu (except Chennai) with the State Government subsidy during 2018-2019 for Kharif Crops.

**I. OBJECTIVES OF PMFBY:**

PMFBY aims at supporting sustainable production in agriculture by way of

- a) Providing financial support to farmers suffering crop loss/damage arising out of unforeseen events.
- b) Stabilizing the income of farmers to ensure their continuance in farming.
- c) Encouraging farmers to adopt innovative and modern Agriculture practices.
- d) Ensuring flow of credit to the agriculture sector, which will, contribute to food security, crop diversification and enhancing growth and competitiveness of agriculture sector besides protecting farmers from production risks

**II. COVERAGE OF FARMERS:**

All farmers including share croppers and tenant farmers growing the notified crops in the notified areas are eligible for coverage.

- Compulsory for Loanee farmers.
- Optional for Non - Loanee farmers.

**III. COVERAGE OF RISKS AND EXCLUSIONS:**

The following stages of the crop and Risks leading to crop loss are covered under the scheme:

1. **PREVENTED SOWING/ PLANTING RISK** – If Insured area is prevented from sowing / planting due to deficit rainfall or adverse seasonal conditions and non release of irrigation water on scheduled date of opening of dam for irrigation in its command areas.
2. **STANDING CROP (SOWING TO HARVESTING)** - Comprehensive risk insurance is provided to cover yield losses due to non - preventable risks viz. Drought, dry spells, flood, inundation, pests and diseases, landslides, natural fire

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and lightening, storm, hailstorm, cyclone typhoon, tempest, hurricane and tornado.

3. **POST-HARVEST LOSSES** - Coverage against specific perils of cyclone, cyclonic rains and unseasonal rains is available only upto a maximum period of two weeks from harvesting, for those crops which are allowed to dry in cut and spread condition in the field after harvesting
4. **LOCALIZED CALAMITIES** - Loss/damage resulting due to occurrence of identified localized risks viz., hailstorm, landslide and inundation affecting isolated farms in the notified area.

In the 40<sup>th</sup> SLCCCI meeting conducted on 27.03.2018 for notification of crops during Kharif 2018, the Committee has authorized the District Level Monitoring Committee under the Chairmanship of District Collector to fix the seasonality discipline for prevented sowing/failed sowing and Post harvest losses at farm level and invoking mid-season adversity for on-account payment (vide G.O.Ms.No.293, Agriculture (AP6) Department, dated 12.9.2016) as done during 2016-2017 and 2017-2018.

#### IV. SUM INSURED:

The Scale of Finance approved by the State Level Technical Committee for 2018-2019 shall be adopted as Sum Insured for the crops notified during 2018-2019 as per Para.No.VII(1) of the Operational Guidelines of under Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana . The Sum Insured will be the same for both loanee and non-loanee farmers.

**V. PREMIUM RATE AND PREMIUM SUBSIDY:****FARMER'S PREMIUM:**

Actuarial Premium Rate (APR) would be charged under PMFBY by the Implementing Agency (IA). The rate of Insurance Charges for Kharif crops (All Food Grains (Cereals, Millets, Pulses) & Oilseeds) payable by the farmer is 2.0% of Sum Insured or Actuarial rate, whichever is less while it is 5% of Sum Insured or Actuarial rate, whichever is less for Annual Commercial / Annual Horticultural Crops.
