Sub : Agriculture – Implementation of Revamped Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana (RPMFBY) by adopting New Co-Insurance Model on 80:20 proportionate sharing basis during Kharif Season 2021 - Notification of Crops, districts and Insurance Units, Sum insured and Approved

Premium Rates(APR) for Agriculture and Horticulture Crops for the Kharif Season 2021 - Go Ahead Communicated – Regarding.

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The Government vide order 1st cited has approved the districtwise, cropwise Actuarial Premium Rates quoted by the selected Insurance Companies, approved the cluster wise Implementing Agencies selected by the Chairman of Tender Finalizing Committee / Director of Agriculture, permitted the Director of Agriculture to issue work orders for 2021-2022 to Agriculture Insurance Company Limited (AICIL)for 12 Clusters (Cluster 2,4,5,6,7,8,9,10,11,12,13 & 14) and IFFCO-TOKIO General Insurance Company Limited for clusters 1 & 3. and permitted the Director of Agriculture / Director of Horticulture & Plantation crops to notify the Kharif crops for which the enrolment window is open and all crops during Special and Rabi seasons of 2021-2022 in concurrence with State level Co-ordination Committee on Crop Insurance (SLCCCI) under Revamped Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana (RPMFBY) by adopting New Co-Insurance Model on 80:20 proportionate sharing basis.

In continuation to that, the meeting of 49th State level Co-ordination Committee on Crop Insurance was held on 16.08.21 and the approved minutes has been communicated vide reference 2nd cited to Director of Agriculture. The Chairman of SLCCCI / Agricultural Production Commissioner & Secretary to Government, Government of Tamil Nadu has permitted the Director of Agriculture to Go-Ahead with the digitization of Insurance Units

Meanwhile Government of India vide reference cited has conveyed their consent for extension of the cut off date for the enrolment of farmers till 31st August, 2021 for Kharif,2021.

Accordingly, all the stake holders are hereby requested to Go Ahead with the enrolment of farmers (Loanee / Non-Loanee) for Crops notified during Kharif Season 2021 under Revamped Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana

(RPMFBY) following the Operational Guidelines issued by the Government of India. The approved list of Notified Crops, districts & Insurance Units, Sum insured and Approved Premium Rates (APR) for Agriculture and Horticulture Crops for the Kharif Season 2021 under Revamped Pradhan Mantri Fasal Bima Yojana (RPMFBY) is enclosed.

It is also informed that the districts and Insurance Units, Sum insured, Approved Premium Rates (APR) and Cut off date for enrolment have been notified on the GOI Portal. The Stakeholders are requested to take earnest effort to maximize the enrolment within the stipulated Cut-off date for each notified crops. The cluster wise implementing Agency & indemnity level are as follows:
